DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP CHILDREN—STAFF CARPARK NOT TO BE USED

ONLY staff, disabled parking and delivery vans are permitted to use the staff carpark. There is an abundance of parking around the school also in the council park grounds. For the safety of all children, we ask that all families abide by this rule and keep our students safe.

PARENT HELPERS

Any parent wishing to help in the classrooms must sign a declaration form at the school office before being allowed to work with children. This form is kept on our file only—it is not a police check. You are also asked to sign in and out each time at the school office.

LATE ARRIVALS

All students who arrive late to school must come to the office to sign in and take a red card to the class teacher. Early leavers also need to come to the office to sign out.

NOTES HOME

All classes send notes home on a regular basis so please ask your child daily if they have a note for you and if they say no... check their bag anyway, there just might be one in there that they forgot about.

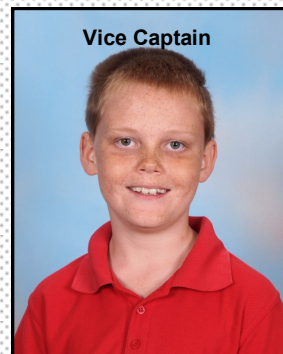
