Courage to Care excursion Year



Last Wednesday, students from Years 5 and 6 visited the Albury Library Museum to participate in the **Courage to Care** program. This program is initiated by B'nai B'rith, the world's oldest community service organisation, to convey messages of social tolerance and living in harmony. Its content is considered to be very relevant to students as they encounter media images of intolerance and prejudice or when they experience racism or bullying at school. The program's primary focus centres around people who were either persecuted or who provided assistance to the Jews during the dark days of World War 2 known as the **Holocaust**. So many people put their lives and those of their families and friends at risk to help those who really needed their help in the face of persecution.

The program encourages students to evaluate the issues of tolerance, racism and stereotyping and challenges those who turn a blind eye rather than to stand up for what they know is right. During the course of the 2 hour session students listened to how those who had survived the Holocaust managed to cope with either going into hiding or being held prisoner all the while knowing that they had lost their homes and possessions and that most of their family members had been killed. The student groups also viewed an exhibition of writings, photos and artefacts from that period and finished up with a 'Living in Harmony' workshop whereby the students were asked to explore their feelings and thoughts on what they had seen and how it was relevant to their daily lives.

Thank you to Miss Farmer for enabling SHPS to participate in such a worthwhile program.
