As a result of feedback from parents and the students 'Tell Them From Me', Springdale Heights Public School has taken a whole school approach and introducing a Peer Support Program. The Peer Support Program is a peer led, skills based, hands on learning program. It encourages peer connections throughout the school and assists students in developing practical skills to enhance social and emotional wellbeing.

To commence the program Mrs Carroll and Mrs McAlister will be taking the Year Six students on a two-day camp to The Great Aussie Resort Wymah!! How good is that!!!! FULLY FUNDED BY THE SCHOOL!!

This wonderful opportunity trains the Year Six students in becoming Peer Leaders of the school.

Following our camp, towards the end of Term One, we will commence our Peer Support lessons and the program will run for the year. The whole school participates in Peer Support for 30 minutes each week.

Two Peer leaders facilitate a small group of 8-10 younger students, who work together through a number of structured activities. A teacher will supervise 2-3 groups in their classroom.

The first module the school will work on is **Keeping Friends - Relationships** helping us explore the concept of friendship, build relationships and develop skills in empathy and critical thinking. The module runs for 8 sessions.

Our first session enables the children to get to know everyone in their group, agreeing on how they will work together and interact cooperatively with others. They will also begin to think about the meaning of friendship.

We encourage you to talk to your children about Peer Support every week as it will help to reinforce the concepts learned in each session.
