We would like to thank Jonathan and Bella from the AFL Clinic for coming to our school to run an AFL clinic for our students.





Year 5-6 H

5/6 H has been focussing on Growth Mindset and Mindfulness.


Growth Mindset encompasses a positive attitude and belief in ourselves when faced with challenges.
