***Deposits are due TODAY for the Year 5/6 Excursion to Canberra.

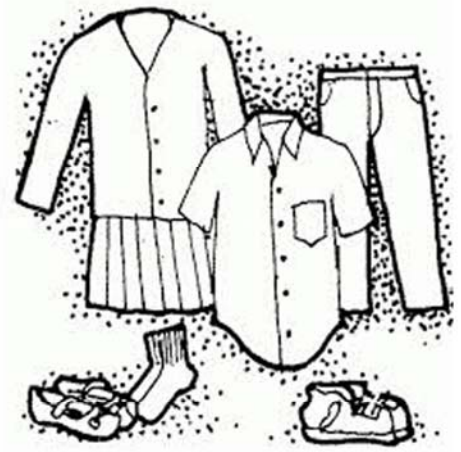
As of today, we have had very few responses and if we don't get the numbers, the excursion will be unable to go ahead.

***Full payment of the Year 6 t-shirts is also due by the end of Term 1!

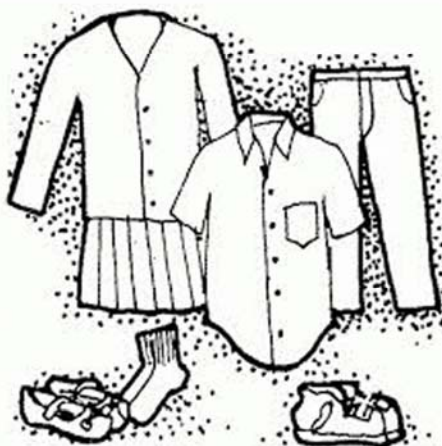
