The Rotary Club of Albury West believe that *'every child deserves the opportunity to become the very best they can be'* and launched the *'Kids With Wings'* initiative.

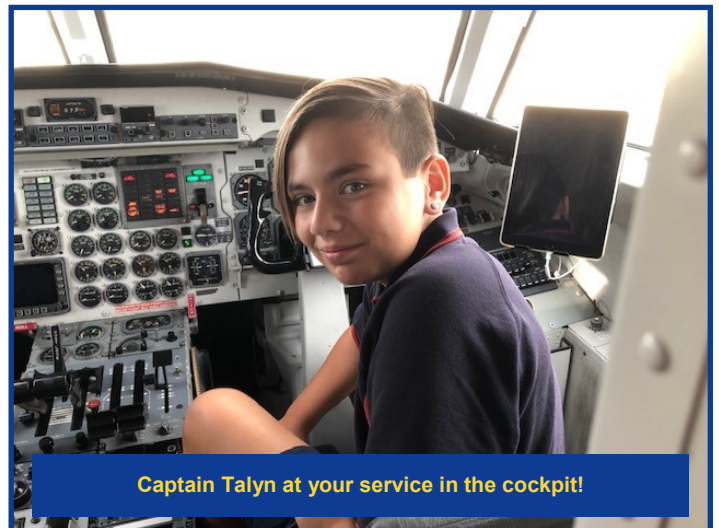

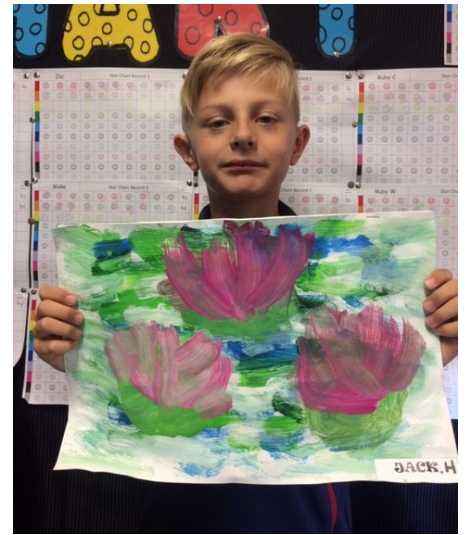

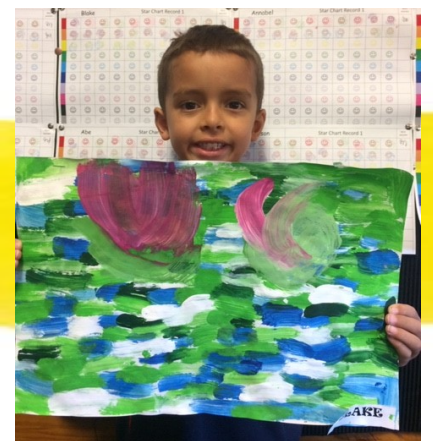
