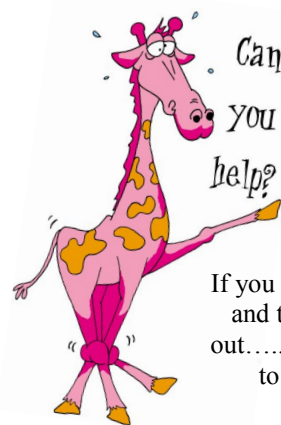


### Soccer

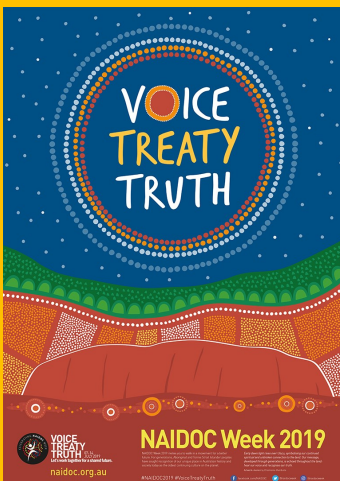
# NAIDOC DAY

## Johnny Cakes

10 minutes preparation + 20 minutes cooking  
By Stewart Luland



### Ingredients:

1kg self-raising flour  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 tablespoon low-fat margarine or olive oil spread  
250ml milk  
500ml water  
1 egg, beaten  
1 tablespoon of canola oil

### Method:

1. Warm milk and margarine until mixed. Add cold water.
2. Mix flour (900g) and salt in large bowl, make a hole in the centre of flour and add  $\frac{1}{2}$  of liquid at a time, stir, until all the liquid is used.
3. Flour bench with some of remaining flour.
4. Knead dough until smooth and mould into shape. Try not to over knead.
5. Make dough into patties – about the size of a hamburger patty or size of the palm of your hand.
6. Heat oil.
7. Add patties and cook until golden brown on both sides.

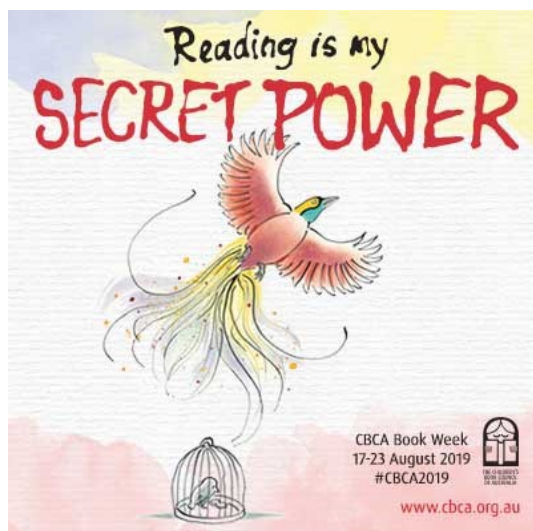
## WE ARE STILL RUNNING THE CANTEEN PANTRY DRIVE

If your child has any new medical conditions or allergies... please let us know. If your child has Asthma, please provide us with a copy of their current Asthma plan. *All medications need to be brought in, in their original chemist issued container.*

### LABEL EVERYTHING!!!!

Please label everything that your child brings to school. Drink bottles, lunch boxes, containers, clothing etc... Our lost property is often filled with un-named items. Replacement of these items must be a huge cost to families that can be avoided if you label everything. Ask your child to check the lost property regularly.

### BIRTHDAY CAKES

Some class teachers allow birthday cakes to be brought in. We ask that you bring in patty cakes only and always ask your class teacher first in case someone in the class has an allergy to some ingredients.
