Thank you for helping make our SRC Appeals Day fundraiser such a success.

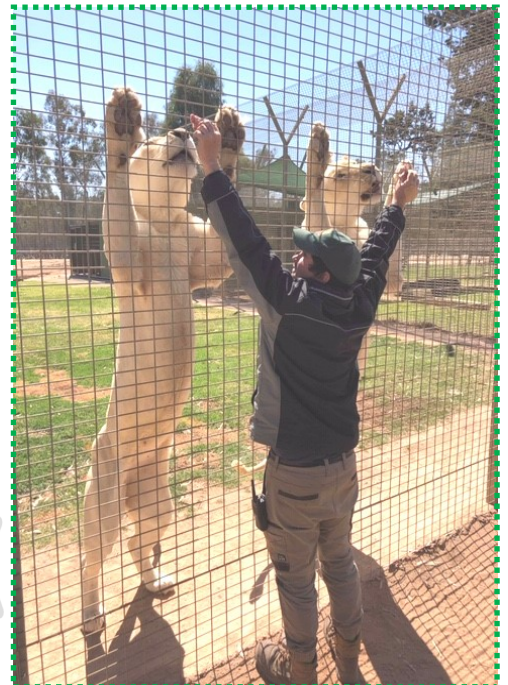
We raised \$531.50 to be divided between FoodShare and a Thailand Children's Village.
