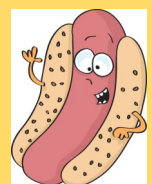

Students presented each SASS staff member with a hand made card and chocolates.

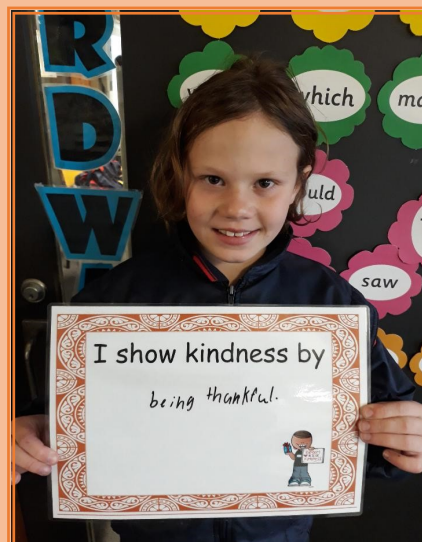
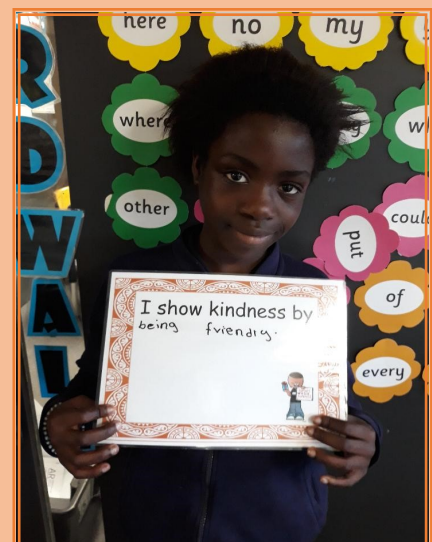
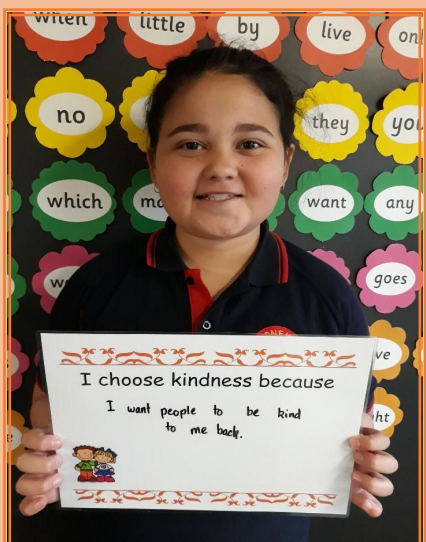
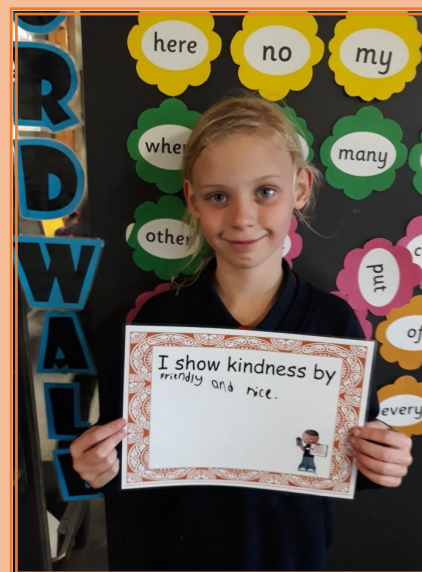
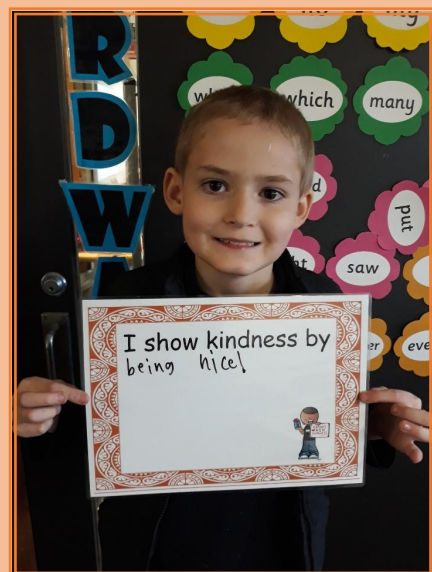
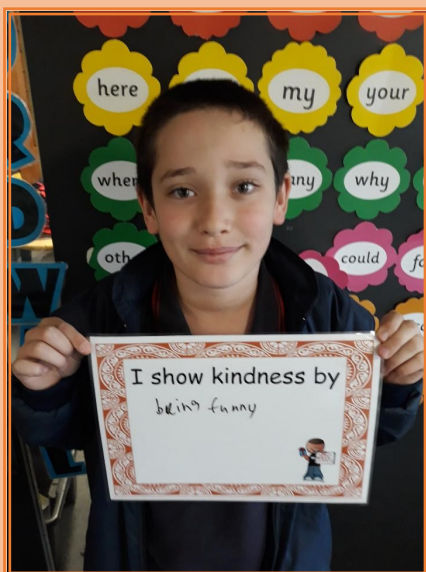
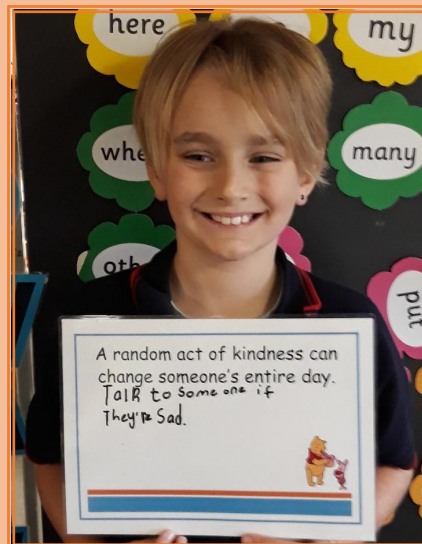
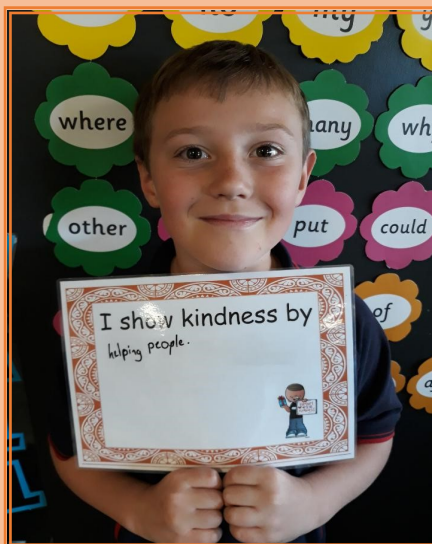
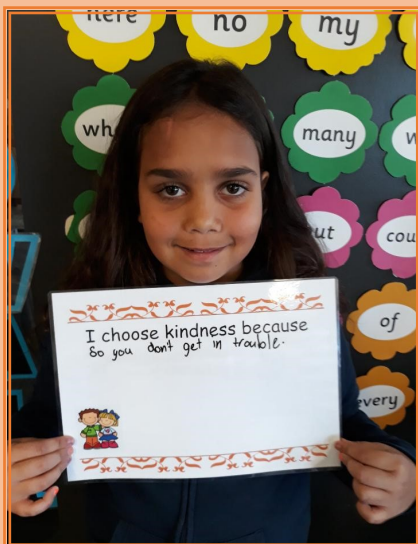
